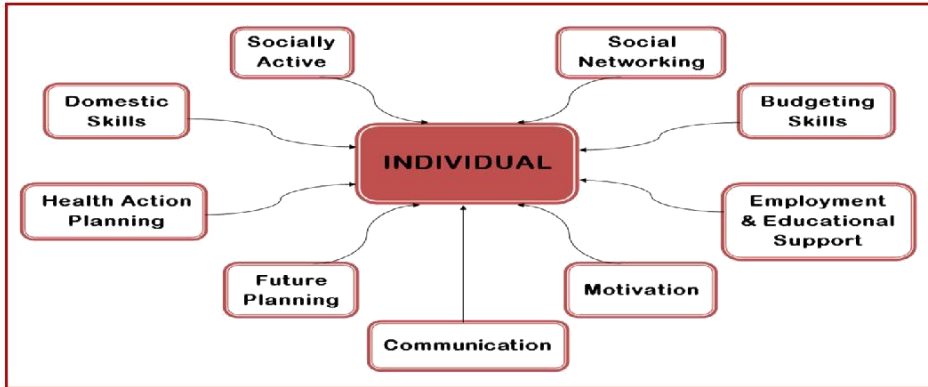


Opportunities to improve life skills

Within the house, individuals benefit from outcome focused support as outlined below:



Joe's story.. Joe came to Lower Broughton Road after the death of his remaining parent, he was over 40 years old. When Joe moved into Lower Broughton Road, he lacked daily living skills as his parent had previously undertaken all his care needs. He displayed a number of verbally and physically challenging behaviours, plus refused to engage with any health professionals.

During his time at Lower Broughton Road, Joe has greatly increased his independent living skills, he has a regular personal care routine, basic cooking and shopping skills, and uses a washing machine and tumble dryer. Joe enjoys a full and active life both within Lower Broughton Road and the local community. Joe is keen to attend health appointments and although he can still be a little verbally challenging when anxious, rarely displays any inappropriate behaviour.

- ◆ Two Registered Residential homes for people with learning disabilities, including those on the autistic spectrum
- ◆ Provides accommodation and support for seven people
- ◆ Undertaking accreditation with National Autistic Society
- ◆ Takes a person centred approach, encouraging independence & focused on outcomes for each individual
- ◆ Supports effective communication and activities of daily living
- ◆ Facilitates access to local inclusive community activities

Lower Broughton Road is close to the town centre and community activities of Salford & Manchester. The service offers people with high support needs a package which includes individualised support & care, in a stable environment, aiding activities of daily living.



The skilled staff team benefit from training and guidance from Potens Behaviour Support & Therapy Team, accessing solutions to communication issues, daily living difficulties and any behaviour that challenges.

Lower Broughton Road offers support to address :

- autistic spectrum disorders
 - Asperger Syndrome - learning disabilities - behaviour that challenges - daily living difficulties
 - non verbal communication
- Support** is offered to enable people to become more independent and valued members of their community.

The staff team are working hard towards gaining accreditation with the National Autistic Society. They feel that this will evidence their knowledge of effective support for people on the autistic spectrum.
