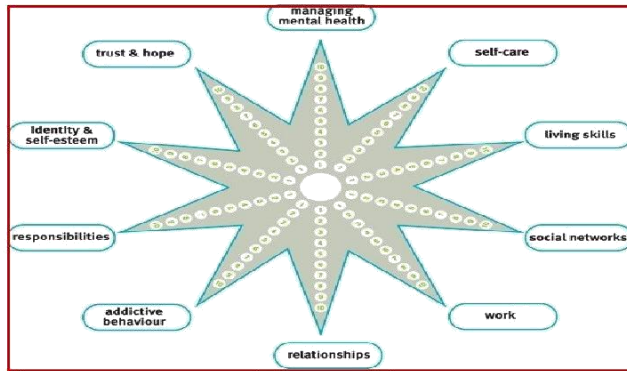


Mansard House offers appropriate support and liaison with local professionals and organisations focused around the ten outcomes of the **Mental Health Recovery Star**:



Dan's story "I'm 28 years old and have lived at Mansard House for just over a year now. Before this I had lived in loads of different places but they never worked out due to my drinking & drug taking and getting into trouble with the police. I only had a bin bag of clothes to my name when I arrived and I hadn't eaten a proper meal in days.

The staff here were really kind. They didn't judge me, they helped me to see what I needed to do to make my life better. They also showed me how to budget my benefits and I now have my own tv, laptop and play station which I saved up for myself. I no longer use drugs and I have really cut down on my drinking too. The staff also helped me find voluntary work which I do 3 full days a week now with a local conservation group. We go all over the North West dry stone walling, planting and repairing fencing in community areas. I really think I've turned my life around since I moved to Mansard House."

Support can also be offered for clients on a Community Treatment Order or Section under the Mental Health Act.
