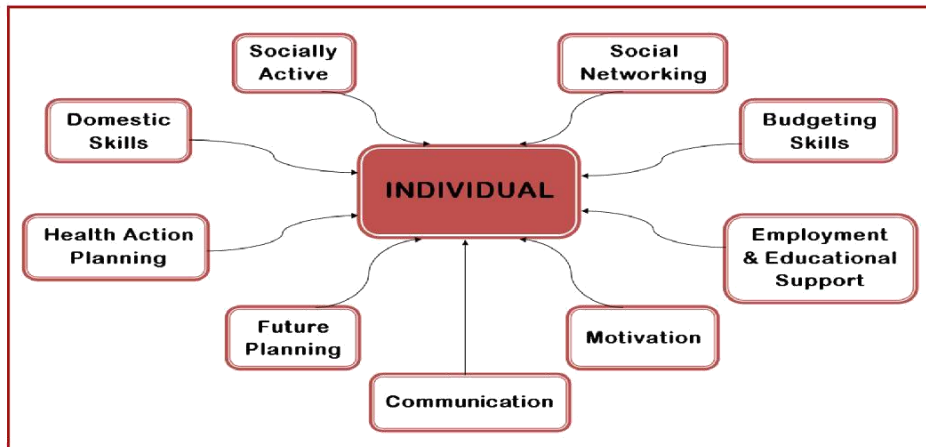


Life Opportunities

Susan's story, Susan has frequent epilepsy episodes and Assistive technology or telecare was suggested as an effective option. A personal detector is worn at all times, and if triggered, alerts support staff immediately through a monitoring device about the size of a phone. This is coupled with detector devices in various rooms of the house, so at all times, the staff team are aware where Susan is, but only intervene if required, ensuring correct risk management to achieve optimum quality of life without being *over supported*."

Ellen is visually impaired but makes herself hot drinks with the use of a specialist kettle.
