
The outreach support service offers appropriate support and liaison with local professionals and organisations focused around the ten outcomes of the **Mental Health Recovery Star**:



Calder View & Pendle View are local residential care services which offer continuity of support to enable successful independent living. **Mike** had been in a residential service for over 12 years, and never expected to live independently. The staff team at Calder View supported him with skills development around his daily living activities, and encouraged a more independent lifestyle. Mike now successfully lives in Potens local supported living accommodation with reduced support from the staff team, enjoys being actively involved in his local community and continues to improve his quality of life.

POTENS SUPPORTED LIVING IN EAST LANCASHIRE

- "Step Down" supported accommodation and support for people with mental health needs
- Providing assured tenancies and individualised support for two or three people in each house
- Support is offered through the Calder View & Pendle View staff team close by, encouraging independence & crisis management
- Rehabilitative support focused around the outcomes of the Mental Health Recovery Star

Working in partnership with a local Landlord, supported accommodation in two or three person shared houses is available. The houses are close to Calder View and Pendle View residential services, offering tenancies and individualised support in Lancashire. All of the houses can access shops, community facilities, local transport, health and support services easily.

The skilled staff teams offer continuity of support from residential care facilities to local community, "step down" houses for individuals with reducing support needs, but 24 on call availability.





The **Supported Living service** offered is through five local refurbished houses, with 2 or 3 personal rooms and a shared kitchen/dining room, living room and bathroom in each house.

The **outreach support service** offers appropriate support to plan the required skill development towards successful independent living, and will be focused around enabling skills, social integration & managing an individual's mental health needs to aid recovery.
