-  We deliver a 24/7 residential services for adults over the age of 18 with severe/enduring and/or acute mental illness. They may also have a learning, sensory or physical disability.
-  We are committed to ensuring quality outcomes for each person, focusing on recovery and pathways to independent community living.
-  Our trained and motivated staff provide support with the introduction of PCAS (Person Centred Active Support) where the people we support are actively encouraged to be as independent as possible.
-  We follow an Autism Practice Manual which was developed by Potens Autism Practice Group. The manual has a comprehensive content including Autism Needs Assessment, Support Planning, Transition Planning, All about Me and Autism Policies. The group meet on a regular basis to discuss promoting Autism through training and introducing the manual into services.
-  The approach used by staff is person centred with the service user driving the level of support as much as possible.
-  We encourage the help and support of families, friends and professionals in the recovery of the individual.
