Larwood House is a Registered Residential Care Home for up to 9 adults with a learning disability and complex needs.

The service comprises of a fully accessible bungalow design with gardens and patio area located in Kirkby in Ashfield.

Taking a person centred approach, support is organised to focus on agreed outcomes, with individual packages of support facilitating access to, and inclusion within their community.

SAFE

People were protected from the risk of abuse or harm. Staff understood their responsibilities to protect people from abuse or harm and there were policies in place to support this, including a whistleblowing policy. Staff told us they knew how to report any concerns they had and how to escalate them if necessary.

CARING

People were cared for by staff who were kind and compassionate. People told us they enjoyed living at Larwood House. One person said, "I love it here" and another said, "The staff are nice to me". We saw positive and respectful interactions between staff and people, we saw them chatting and laughing together.

EFFECTIVE

The provider had an induction process in place for new staff as part of the development of their caring role. This was aligned to the Care Certificate. This showed the provider recognised the need to ensure staff had the necessary training and skills to meet people's needs.

RESPONSIVE

Staff promoted people's rights and adapted support to make sure everyone had a voice and was treated equally. One staff member told us "We treat people as individuals, they have rights and their own opinions, and it's important that they contribute to discussions about things that affect them."

WELL-LED

We received positive feedback from external services and practitioners. For example, a social worker told us that staff worked with them to plan a smooth transfer for a person moving to Larwood House. They also commented on the positive communication they had with staff.
