The Hollies was opened in April 2018 and is an extended bungalow in the heart of Barry town, which is surrounded by beautiful coastline, countryside and parks galore.

We are central to shops, supermarkets, pubs, restaurants, athletic clubs, churches, mosques, fairground, beaches (where we have access for a fee to beach huts and beach wheelchairs), leisure centers, museums, GP surgeries, chemists, opticians, hospitals along with having bus and rail links to Cardiff and other places of interest which are all accessible.
